Mini Art Show Information



- Mini Art Show: Tuesday, July 1st Friday, July 25th
- Submission Dates: Monday, June 2nd Monday, June 30th*
- The last day to submit artwork(s) is Monday, June 30th @
 4:59 pm; submissions will not be accepted after June 30th
- Judging for the 7 winners will be Tuesday, July Ist Saturday, July 5th
- · Winners will be announced on Monday, July 7th
- People's Choice will be announced on Monday, July 21st
- All artwork must be picked up no later than Thursday, July 31st @ 7:59 pm.

ART CONTEST RULES

- · 4 Age Groups: 2-5, 6-10, 11-17, 18+
- Submissions <u>must</u> be individual work. If assistance is needed, family members can help, but the majority work must be completed by the participant(s) only.
- NO obscene content. Must be family-friendly, original artwork.
- Participants will be provided a 4x4 canvas (more than one
 if entering other categories.
- Participants must provide their <u>own</u> picture frame for the Photography category.*
- Participants will fill out a form, selecting one or more categories. They do not have to participate in all of them.





Category #1: Drawing

 Participants may only use graphite sketching pencils, charcoal pencils, colored pencils, markers, crayons or oil pastels.

Category #2: Painting

 Participants may use watercolor paints, acrylic paints or tempera paints.

Category #3: Fashion (Fiber Art)

 Participants may use buttons, denim patches, fabric patches, yarn, beads, ribbons & other embellishments.

Category #4: Photography

- Participants may take photos of family, friends, a headshot, landscapes, etc.
- Photos need to be printed; can be no bigger than a 4x6.*

Category #5: 3D Art

- Participants may use 3D puff paint, wire-wrapping, Play-Doh, Air-Dry Clay, or Modeling Clay.
- 3D printing will **NOT** be accepted as an option.

Category #6: Silhouettes

- Participants may use their favorite silhouette design (stars, cats, trees, etc.)
- Participants may use any style of art from the 5 previous categories (drawing, painting, fiber art, photography & 3D.)

Winner Selection

• 1 winner from each category & 1 overall winner out of the 6.
