What is the FLIGHT PATH Grant? It is a grant that includes materials and a monetary honorarium to help cover the cost of events, programs, and outreach for the purpose of native bird and bird migration education.

With more than one billion birds killed by window strikes each year in the United States alone, FLIGHT PATH taps into the popularity of bird watching and provides local communities with fun activities to get to know their local birds, promote bird health, and bird safety. We will feature book displays, several programs, and outreach campaigns starting in September through next spring that reflect bird and bird-related topics.




