This Library also supports St. Anne’s Community Christmas Tree outreach. Starting on Thursday, November 13th, patrons can drop off gently used and new items for local children in need, up to 18 years of age. The deadline for the program will be closing on Monday, December 15th.

On Thursday, November 13th, we expect the arrival of the “Elves for Elders” ornaments. The Library will host a tree in our foyer, so that patrons may select an ornament for a local senior citizen who may not otherwise have a merry Christmas.
